Will the Minister of SHIPPING be pleased to state:

- (a) whether it is a fact that Government is planning to take up a new set of technically viable National Waterways;
- (b) if so, the details thereof, National Waterway-wise; and
- (c) whether the technical study of viability of these National Waterways have been done?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF SHIPPING (SHRI MANSUKH L. MANDAVIYA)

(a) to (c): Yes, Sir. Subsequent to declaration of 111 National Waterways (NWs) (including five existing NWs) under the National Waterways Act, 2016, feasibility studies have been undertaken by the Inland Waterways Authority of India (IWAI) in respect of 106 NWs. As per feasibility reports completed so far, 36 NWs have been found technically viable by the IWAI and developmental activities have been initiated on 8 NWs as per list enclosed at Annex.
