(a) to (d): Air India has entered into agreement with Ministry of Defence and Ministry of Home Affairs to operate Charter flights as per following details:

Ministry of Home Affairs

- 1. Kolkata-Agartala-Kolkata: 05 flights per week
- 2. Kolkata-Aizwal-Kolkata: 01 flight per week
- 3. Kolkata-Imphal-Kolkata: 03 flights per week

4. Delhi-Leh-Delhi : 02 flights per week

- 5. Delhi-Jammu-Srinagar-Jammu-Delhi: 06 flights per week
- 6. Delhi-Dibrugarh-Guwahati-Delhi: 02 flights per week

Ministry of Defence

1. Delhi-Leh-Delhi : 05 flights per week

2. Chennai-Port Blair-Chennai: 01 flight in 15 days
