The erstwhile Centrally Sponsored Intensification of Forest Management Scheme (IFMS) has been revised and replaced as Forest Fire Prevention and Management Scheme (FPM) in 2017-18. The operational guidelines of the FPM scheme has been circulated to all States and Union Territories including Odisha.
