LAUNCH OF SVEP

3947. SHRI D. KUPENDRA REDDY:

Will the Minister of **RURAL DEVELOPMENT** be pleased to state:

- (a) whether Government has launched the Start-up Village Entrepreneurship Programme (SVEP) in the country and if so, the details thereof, State-wise including Karnataka; and
- (b) the details of the sectors which have been identified for the said programme in the State along with the number of entrepreneurs likely to be supported every year?

(a): Start-up Village Entrepreneurship Programme (SVEP), a sub-scheme under the National Rural Livelihoods Mission (NRLM) was launched with the objective of helping rural poor to come out of poverty by helping them set-up sustainable enterprises. As on 28th Feb, 2018, the scheme is being implemented in 114 blocks across 19 states.

State wise detail of SVEP implementation is as follows:
