Will the Minister of FINANCE be pleased to state:

- (a) whether Government is contemplating to allow export of pure gold from the country in the course of the proposed comprehensive gold policy of the country;
- (b) if so, the details thereof and the present status of the proposal;
- (c) whether this move may pave way for the import of raw gold into the country; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof and the steps taken by Government in this regard?

ANSWER MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF FINANCE (Shri P. Radhakrishnan)

(a) to (d) In Union Budget 2018 - 19 it is announced that the Government will formulate a comprehensive gold policy to develop gold as an asset class. However, at present, there is no proposal to allow export of pure gold.
