IMPORT DUTY ON MOTOR BIKES/ AUTOMOBILE PRODUCTS

4064. SHRI BHUBANESWAR KALITA:

Will the Minister of FINANCE be pleased to state:

- (a) whether it is a fact that Government has raised import duty on motor bikes and automobile products, if so, the details thereof;
- (b) whether some countries have expressed concern in the matter, if so, the details thereof; and
- (c) whether Government intends to sort out the issue with those countries?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF FINANCE
(SHRI SHIV PRATAP SHUKLA)

(a): The Government has increased Basic Customs Duty from 7.5 % / 10 % to 15 % on specified automobile parts in the Budget 2018-19. However, there has been no increase in the import duty on motor bikes.

(b): No such concerns have been received from any country.
