4080. SHRI. NARESH GUJRAL:

Will the Minister of FINANCE be pleased to state:

- (a) The total amount of money received through the Foreign Institutional Investors (FIIs) route that is parked through debt funds in the country; and
- (b) Total investments made by FIIs both in debt and equity in the last three years, year-wise data?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF FINANCE (SHRI P.RADHAKRISHNAN)

- (a): Pursuant to notification of Securities and Exchange Board of India (Foreign Portfolio Investors) Regulations, 2014, existing Foreign Institutional Investors (FIIs), sub-accounts and Qualified Foreign Investors(QFIs) have been merged into a new investor class, termed as "Foreign Portfolio Investor"(FPI). The value of the total net investment of FPIs in Debt Mutual Funds at acquisition cost is 15,426.83 Crores and at Current valuation is 15,744.96 Crores as on February 28, 2018
- (b): The net investments made by FPIs in equity, debt and hybrid instruments during the last three years is as under:
