GOVERNMENT HOSPITALS IN THE COUNTRY

4122. SHRI PRABHAT JHA:

Will the Minister of **HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE** be pleased to state:

- (a) the total number of Government hospitals in the country, the State-wise details thereof;
- (b) the State-wise number of shortage of doctors in Government hospitals;
- (c) the State-wise details of shortage of nursing staff in Government hospitals; and
- (d) the State-wise details of availability and non-availability of blood banks in the country?

**ANSWER

(a): As per Rural Health Statistics 2016-17, as on 31st March 2017 there were 779 District Hospitals(DHs), 1108 Sub District/Sub Divisional Hospitals(SDHs), 5624 Community Health Centres (CHCs), 25,650 Primary Health Centres (PHCs) and 1,56,231 Sub Centres (SCs) across the country. State/UT wise details are given in **Annexure I**.

(b): As per information provided by Medical Council of India, there are a total 10,41,395 allopathic doctors registered with the State Medical Councils/Medical Council of India as on 31st December, 2017. Assuming 80% availability, it is estimated that around 8.33 lakh doctors may be actually available for active service. Besides, there are 7.63 lakh Ayurveda Unani and Homeopathy (AUH) doctors in the country. Assuming 80% availability, it is estimated that around 6.10 lakh Ayurveda, Unani and Homeopath(AUH) doctors may actually be available for active service and considered together with allopathic doctors, it gives a doctor population ratio of 1:921, whereas WHO norm is 1:1000.

Further, State/UT wise sanctioned, in position and shortfall of allopathic doctors in DHs and SDHs are given in Annexure II. Further, required, in position, shortfall of specialists(allopathic) in CHCs, sanctioned, in position, shortfall of allopathic General Duty Medical Officers in CHCs and required, in position, shortfall of allopathic doctors in PHCs are given in Annexure- III, IV and V respectively.

(c): State/UT wise sanctioned and in position nursing staff in DHs and SDHs are given in Annexure VI. Further, required, in position and shortfall of nursing staff in CHCs and PHCs are given in Annexure VII.

(d): State/UT wise details of blood banks are given in Annexure VIII.
