#### AYURVEDA HEALTH CLINICS IN THE COUNTRY

### 4129. SHRI DHARMAPURI SRINIVAS:

Will the Minister of **HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE** be pleased to state:

- (a) whether it is a fact that the Ministry is planning to set up Ayurveda Health Clinics across the country to boost the rural health care;
- (b) if so, the details thereof; and
- (c) the details of the other facilities being provided in the Primary Health Centres?

# ANSWER THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE (SHRI ASHWINI KUMAR CHOUBEY)

- (a) & (b): Government of India has adopted a strategy of co-location of AYUSH facilities at Primary Health Centres (PHCs), Community Health Centres (CHCs) and District Hospitals (DHs) etc. for AYUSH system including Ayurveda, thus enabling choice to the patients for different systems of medicines under single window. Under National Health Mission (NHM), support is provided for the engagement of AYUSH Doctors / paramedics by the Department of Health & Family Welfare, while the support for AYUSH infrastructure and equipment / furniture are provided by Ministry of AYUSH under National AYUSH Mission (NAM).
