- (c) if so, the details thereof?

(a) to (c) The Government of Punjab had sent proposals to amend the IPC and the CrPC for preventing sacrilege of Guru Granth Sahib vide the IPC (Punjab Amendment) Bill, 2016 and the CrPC (Punjab Amendment) Bill, 2016, but had subsequently requested to withdraw the bills, and same had been returned to the State Government.
