(a): All India Council for Technical Education (AICTE), a statutory body of Government of India, under the administrative control of Ministry of Human Resource Development, grants approval of the following Diploma/UG/PG Courses relating to mining in respect of AICTE approved engineering and technology Institutes in the country:

**Diploma:** (i) Mine Engineering (ii) Mine Surveying (iii) Mining and Mine Surveying (iv) Mining Engineering

**Under Graduation (UG):** (i) Mine Engineering (ii) Mining Engineering

**Post Graduation (PG) :** Mining Engineering

(b) and (c): There is no proposal with Ministry of Human Resource Development to open new mining university in the country.
