- (a) whether it is a fact that large number of our paramilitary personnel have been killed in recent times;
- (b) if so, the number of such casualties during the last three years, yearwise; and
- (c) the modern facilities and equipment provided to them to combat this situation without suffering much or no loss of life?

(a) & (b): The number of Central Armed Police Force (CAPFs) & Assam Rifles (AR) personnel killed in action during the last three years upto 30.11.2018, are as under:-
