GROWTH IN SKILL DEVELOPMENT THROUGH SDCS

Will the Minister of SKILL DEVELOPMENT AND ENTREPRENEURSHIP be pleased to state:

- (a) names of the States in the country, in chronological order in terms of growth in skill development and entrepreneurship;
- (b) State-wise number of Skill Development Centres (SDCs) established so far during the last three years and the number of unemployed persons provided employment;
- (c) the amount provided by Government to the States in the said period under the said scheme; and
- (d) whether Government proposes to increase this amount and if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor?

(a) and (b) Under Skill India Mission, Ministry of Skill Development and Entrepreneurship through National Skill Development Corporation (NSDC) is implementing a flagship scheme Pradhan Mantri Kaushal Vikas Yojana (PMKVY) 2016-20. This scheme has two components known as Centrally Sponsored Centrally Managed (CSCM) being implemented by NSDC and Centrally Sponsored State Managed (CSSM) being implemented by State Skill Development Missions of the States/ UTs. Under the PMKVY 2016-20 scheme, as on 30.11.2018, 33.93 lakh (appx.) candidates have been trained under STT (24.13 lakh), RPL (9.08 lakh) and Special Project (0.72 lakh) across the country in various sector. The States wise details of the candidates trained in chronological order (highest to order) under PMKVY 2016-20 is given at **Annexure I**

Under PMKVY 2016-20, for imparting the skill training, the accreditation and affiliation of training centres (TCs) are being done under single window IT application known as SMART. As on 30.11.2018, 9,417 TCs (8,101 TCs under CSCM and 1,316 TCs under CSSM) have been empanelled under PMKVY 2016-20. The State/UT-wise details of Training Centers under PMKVY 2016-20 are given at of **Annexure II**.

(c) and (d) CSCM component of PMKVY 2016-20 is being implemented pan India by NSDC, thus, no State/UTs-wise fund is sanctioned under this component. However, under CSSM component of PMKVY 2016-20, 25% of the funds and corresponding physical targets of PMKVY 2016-20 have been allocated to the States/UTs for the implementation of scheme through State Skill Development Missions. Ministry has received proposals from 36 States/UTs and after evaluation of proposals Ministry has in-principle approved the physical target of 20.18 lakh and financial target of 3,050 Cr. for 36 States/UTs for FY 2016-20. As on 01.12.2018, Rs. 741 Cr. (approx) has been disbursed to 35 States/UTs.
