- (a) whether it is a fact that growing population of pigeons cause health hazards;
- (b) if so, the details thereof; and
- (c) steps taken/being taken by Government to control the population of pigeons?

- (a) and (b) The populations of Blue Rock Pigeon (*Columba livia*) are a common sight in human habitation. However no report has been received in the Ministry indicating that the population of pigeons are causing health hazards.
