GOLD MINING IN THE COUNTRY

1514. SHRI SAMBHAJI CHHATRAPATI:

Will the Minister of MINES be pleased to state:

- (a) whether Government has any taken special measures for exploration of gold in different parts of the country followed by mining for depending upon commercial viability;
- (b) the most potential gold mines in the country worthy of extraction of the precious metal from commercial perspective;
- (c) whether Government has auctioned any gold mine in the last three years; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof and total quantity of gold extracted in last three years, minewise, year-wise?

ANSWER

THE MINISTER OF STATE FOR MINES AND COAL (SHRI HARIBHAI PARATHIBHAI CHAUDHARY)

- (a) GSI carries out different stages of exploration for different mineral commodities including gold, depending on the geological potential of the area in different parts of the country. GSI hands over the resource bearing mineral investigation reports to the concerned state governments for consideration in the auctioning process. The details of gold investigation programmes carried out by GSI in last three years (FS 2015-16 to FS 2017-18) as well as the gold investigation programmes taken up in the current field season (FS 2018-19) are given in Annexure-I & II.
- (b) Presently gold is being produced in four mines i.e. (i) Kunderkocha Gold Mine, Jharkhand (ii) Hutti, Karnataka (iii) Uti, Karnataka and (iv) Hirabuddini, Karnataka.
- (c) Four gold mines/blocks have been auctioned in last three years, the details are as under –
