Midterm budget cut

1597. SHRI AHAMED HASSAN:

Will the Minister of YOUTH AFFAIRS AND SPORTS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether it is a fact that Ministry is facing a midterm budget cut due to low spending;
- (b) if so, details of amount spent out of allocated budget in the fiscal year 2017-18; and
- (c) details of amount spent on Sports Authority of India (SAI) centres in the country for the period of 2016-17, State-wise?

ANSWER

- (a) Review of budget allocation in the fiscal year 2018-19 follows a prescribed procedure. The allocation for this Ministry was discussed in Ministry of Finance. However, no final decision in this regard has been taken and communicated yet.
- (b) During the fiscal year 2017-18, the Ministry of Youth Affairs and Sports spent an amount of ₹1722.71 cr.
- (c) Govt. /SAI does not allocate/ spend the amount State-wise. However, the details of the amount spent on Sports Authority of India (SAI) centers/ regional centre-wise during 2016-17 is annexed.
