**SURVEY ON PM SCHEMES**

1920. SHRI A. VIJAYAKUMAR:

Will the Minister of STATISTICS AND PROGRAMME IMPLEMENTATION be pleased to state:

- (a) whether Government has conducted any survey on Prime Minister Schemes, introduced since 2014;
- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) whether it is a fact that many of the PM Schemes have not achieved desired results due to poor funding; and
- (d) if so, the reasons therefor?

**ANSWER**

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF STATISTICS AND PROGRAMME IMPLEMENTATION AND MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF PARLIAMENTARY AFFAIRS [SHRI VIJAY GOEL]

(a) & (b): The National Sample Survey Office (NSSO), Ministry of Statistics and Programme Implementation conducted nation-wide Swachh Bharat Surveys during May-June 2015 and July – December, 2017 as a part of NSS 72nd round (July 2015 – June 2016) and NSS 75th round (July 2017 – June 2018) respectively to assess sanitary conditions in rural and urban areas of the country. The main findings on sanitary conditions are given in statement at Annexure.

The survey on Pradhan Mantri Mudra Yojna (PMMY) was launched during April, 2018 by the Ministry of Labour & Employment to assess employment generation under PMMY. The field work under PMMY scheme has been completed on 30th November, 2018 and data entry is in progress.

(c) & (d): This information is not maintained by the Ministry.
