(a) & (b): Under Swachh Bharat Mission (Urban) various steps have been taken for waste management including policy intervention, conducting Swachh Survekshan & Star Rating for Garbage Free Cities, continuous monitoring, periodical reviews, issue of various technical advisories and guidelines, Information Education & Communication (IEC) activities, training programmes and workshops, etc. Further, Government of India provides additional central assistance of 35% of the total project cost to all statutory cities/ towns as per the guidelines of SBM (Urban) for Solid Waste Management.

(c): Status of implementation of Solid Waste Management Rules, 2016 under SBM (U) is as under:
