(a) whether it is a fact that the International Boxing Association is likely to reopen bids for hosting Mens World Boxing Championships in the year 2021;

(c) whether Government has taken up the matter with the Boxing Federation of India; and (d) if so, the details thereof?

(a): International Sports Federations(ISFs) including International Boxing Association are responsible for overall administration and development of the concerned Sports globally including organizing the World Championship of a particular Sport. National Sports Federation (NSF) affiliated by ISFs are responsible for the development and promotion of a sports discipline in the country, which in the case of Boxing is Boxing Federation of India (BFI). Government does not deal directly with the ISFs including International Boxing Association. As per information provided by BFI there is no such proposal.
