**RANKING OF INDIAN AVIATION SECURITY**

- (a) whether it is a fact that the International Civil Aviation Organisation (ICAO) has placed the aviation security of India even below Nepal, Bangladesh and Myanmar in ranking;
- (b) if so, the reasons therefor;
- (c) the steps taken by Government to improve the aviation security of the country; and
- (d) if not, the reasons therefor?

(a) & (b): No, Sir.
