STATUS OF AIR CARGO COMPLEX VISAKHAPATNAM

Will the Minister of CIVIL AVIATION be pleased to state:-

- (a) what is the latest status of the Air Cargo Complex near Visakhapatnam, the details thereof; and
(b) by when, it is likely to be completed and the total cost involved, the details thereof?

ANSWER

(a) & (b) Airports Authority of India (AAI) and its wholly owned subsidiary, namely, AAI Cargo Logistics & Allied Services Company Limited (AAICLAS), have already created the infrastructure for handling international and domestic air cargo at Visakhapatnam airport. For operations and maintenance (O&M), international air cargo handling has been entrusted to M/s. Andhra Pradesh Trade Promotion Corporation Limited (APTPC), who have been allotted an area admeasuring 558 square meters of covered area and another 200 square meters of paved area in July 2017. Similarly, AAICLAS has entrusted the O&M responsibility of the Common User Domestic Cargo Terminal (CUDCT) for domestic cargo handling operations to M/s. Delex Cargo India Private Limited, who have been allotted an area admeasuring 407 square meters of covered area and another 200 square meters of paved area each at city-side and air-side in September, 2015. The air cargo facilities at Visakhapatnam airport are fully operational.
