(a): The objective of the project is set up Electromagnetic Environmental Effects (E3) Laboratory measurement and consultancy services in defence and strategic sector of Electromagnetic Interference/Electromagnetic Compatibility & Electromagnetic Pulse.

(b), (c) and (d): The project is stand alone project and not divided into phases. Project duration has been extended by two years without cost enhancement.
