Will the Minister of HOUSING AND URBAN AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

- (a) the number of houses which have been completed which are to be provided to the poor particularly to those who are living in jhuggis (slums) in various urban areas; and
- (b) if so, by when these completed houses will be distributed to the needy persons and how many houses have already been distributed to the needy till 31st January, 2020 in various parts of the country?

(a)& (b): The number of houses completed which are to be provided to the poor particularly to those who are living in jhuggis (slums) in various urban areas under various urban housing schemes of the Ministry of Housing and Urban Affairs is 12,18,692. Out of 12,18,692 houses, 10,96,127 houses have already been distributed to the needy till 31st January, 2020. The concerned State/Union Territory Governments have further been requested to distribute the remaining houses to the needy persons.
