- (b) the details of children who have been rescued under the NCLP scheme;**
- (c) whether Government has conducted any follow-up on the rescued children; and**
- (d) if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor?**

**(a): The present status of National Child Labour Project (NCLP) Scheme, State/UT-wise is at Annexure-I.**

**(b): The number of children who were rescued/withdrawn from work, rehabilitated and mainstreamed under NCLP Scheme during the FY 2018-19, State-wise is at Annexure-II.**

**(c) & (d): Under the NCLP Scheme, the children in the age group of 9-14 years are rescued/ withdrawn from work and enrolled in the NCLP Special Training Centres, where they are provided with bridge education, vocational training, mid-day meal, stipend, health care, etc. before being mainstreamed into formal education system. The children in the age group of 5-8 years are directly linked to the formal education system through a close coordination with the Sarva Shiksha Abhiyan.**

**The District Project Society through its volunteers is to maintain record of mainstreaming data and update it for next one year since mainstreaming.**
