ALLOCATION OF FUNDS TO MANIPUR UNDER MGNREGA

- (a) the details of funds allocated to the State of Manipur for employment guarantee scheme, MGNREGA, in the last five years; and
- (b) the details of the number of people in rural areas of Manipur who have benefited from these schemes?

(a): The Mahatma Gandhi National Rural Employment Guarantee Scheme (Mahatma Gandhi NREGS) provides at least 100 days of wage employment in a financial year to every rural household whose adult member volunteers to do unskilled manual work. It is a demand driven wage employment programme. Hence no State/UT-wise allocation of funds is made. Central fund released to Manipur under Mahatma Gandhi NREGS during the last five years is as under:
