Quality Education at Primary Level

1166. SHRI NEERAJ SHEKHAR:

Will the Minister of EDUCATION be pleased to state:

- (a) the details of schemes being run by Government to improve quality of education at primary level along with augmentation of infrastructure in primary schools in the country, scheme-wise;
- (b) the details of fund allocated, released, and utilised during 2019-20, 2020-21 and 2021- 22 till date, scheme-wise and State-wise; and
- (c) the details of percentage of primary schools covered under internet infrastructure/facility in the country, State-wise?

**ANSWER
MINISTER OF EDUCATION
(SHRI DHARMENDRA PRADHAN)**

(a): The Department of School Education and Literacy has launched an Integrated Scheme for School Education – Samagra Shiksha from 2018-19. It is an overarching programme for the school education sector extending from pre-school to class XII and aims to ensure inclusive and equitable quality education at all levels of school education.

Under the scheme of Samagra Shiksha, States and UTs are supported for strengthening of existing government schools including primary schools, for improvement of quality of education and, for creation and augmentation of infrastructure facilities based on proposals received from respective State/UT, their eligibility as per norms of the scheme and physical and financial progress of the State/UT in respect of works approved earlier.

(b): The details of funds allocated, released and utilised during 2019-20, 2020-21 and 2021- 22 till date, under Samagra Shiksha Scheme, State-wise, is at **Annexure-I**.

(c): The details of percentage of primary schools covered under internet infrastructure/facility in the country, State-wise, is enclosed at **Annexure-II**.
