ALLOCATION OF FUNDS TO STATES UNDER JJM

2336 SHRI JOHN BRITTAS:

Will the Minister of JAL SHAKTI be pleased to state:

- (a) the allocation made to States under Jal Jeevan Mission (JJM) for the last three years, State-wise;
- (b) whether proportion of funds allocated to States has changed considerably; and
- (c) if so, the reasons therefor?

ANSWER

(SHRI PRAHLAD SINGH PATEL)

(a) to (c) Since August 2019, Government of India in partnership with States, is implementing Jal Jeevan Mission (JJM) to make provision of tap water connection to every rural household of the country by 2024.

The estimated outlay for the implementation of the Jal Jeevan Mission is Rs. 3.60 lakh Crore, out of which Central share is Rs. 2.08 lakh Crore. Over the last two years, Central allocation under JJM has increased substantially as the Government is committed to provide adequate funds for provision of tap water supply to every rural household based on requirement/ utilization reported by the State.

Details of State/ UT-wise allocation of Central fund under JJM, in 2019-20, 2020-21 & 2021-22 are **annexed**.
