- (c) if so, the details thereof, State-wise and if not, the reasons therefor; and
- (d) the steps taken to increase the storage capacity in each State during the last three years, year-wise and State-wise?

(a): The details of foodgrains procured and price paid to the farmers during last three months are as under:

- I. Paddy at Annexure-I
- II. Wheat at Annexure-II
- III. Coarsegrain at Annexure-III
- IV- Pulses at Annexure-IV

(b) and (c): The State-wise total storage capacity available with FCI and State Agencies for storage of central pool stocks as on 30.06.2021 is at **Annexure-V**.

(d): The storage capacity depends on the level of procurement, offtake under National Food Security Act (NFSA) & Other Welfare Scheme (OWS) and requirements to maintain buffer stocks. FCI assesses the storage capacity on regular basis and based on the storage gap assessment, storage capacities are created/hired through following schemes:-

1. Private Entrepreneurs Guarantee (PEG) Scheme
2. Centre Sector Scheme (CSS).
3. Construction of SILO's under PPP mode
4. Hiring of godown from CWCs/SWCs/State Agencies
5. Private Warehousing Scheme (PWS)
