SAFE DRINKING WATER TO HOUSEHOLDS UNDER JJM

91 SHRI NEERAJ SHEKHAR:

Will the Minister of JAL SHAKTI be pleased to state:

- (a) the details of households which have been provided with safe drinking water during 2019-20, 2020-21 and 2021-22 under Jal Jeevan Mission (JJM), so far, State-wise;
- (b) the details of targeted households to be provided with safe drinking water during financial year 2021-22, State-wise; and
- (c) the details of target fixed to provide safe drinking water during financial year 2020-21 and the details of households actually provided with safe drinking water, State-wise?

(a) to (c) At the time of announcement of Jal Jeevan Mission on 15th August, 2019, out of 18.93 Crore rural households, 3.23 Crore households (17%) were reported to have tap water supply. The year-wise tap water connections to rural households planned and achievement made so far under Jal Jeevan Mission are as under:
