ALLOCATION OF FUNDS UNDER JJM

108 SHRI NEERAJ SHEKHAR:

Will the Minister of JAL SHAKTI be pleased to state:

(a) the details of fund allocated, released and utilised under Jal Jeevan Mission (JJM) for provision of tap water in every rural household during 2021-22 till 20th November, 2021, State-wise;

(b) the details of target for provision of tap water in rural households during 2021-22, State-wise; and

(c) the details of the number of households which have been provided with tap water facilities during 2021-22 till 20th November, 2021, State-wise?

ANSWER

(a) Since August 2019, Government of India in partnership with States, is implementing Jal Jeevan Mission (JJM) – Har Ghar Jal to make provision of tap water supply to every rural household by 2024. The State/ UT-wise details of fund allocated, release and utilized under JJM during 2021-22 till date is at **Annex-I**.

(b)&(c) On 15th August, 2019, at the time of announcement of Jal Jeevan Mission, out of 18.93 Crore rural households, 3.23 Crore (17%) households were reported to have tap water connections. Since then, additional 5.32 Crore (27.65%) rural households have been provided with tap water connections. Thus, as of date, out of 19.22 Crore rural households in the country, 8.55 Crore (44.5%) households have provision of tap water supply in their homes. Year-wise timelines finalized by States/ UTs for making provision of tap water supply to every rural household is as under:

Provision of tap water supply to all rural households have been made in Goa, Telangana, Haryana, A&N Islands, Puducherry and Daman & Diu and Dadra & Nagar Haveli.

As reported, 1.26 Crore rural households have been provided with tap water connections in 2021-22 till 25.11.2021. State/ UT-wise details are at **Annex-II**.
