Will the Minister of *Finance* be pleased to state:

- (a) what is Off-budget borrowing;
- (b) the Off-budget borrowing of the Union Government in 2019-20 and 2020-21 according to different department numbers, including financial support extended through loans from National Social Security Fund (NSSF);
- (c) the total public borrowing of the Union Government in 2019-20 and 2020-21; and
- (d) whether Off-budget borrowings of the Union Government are included in the total public borrowings of the Government of India?

- (a) Extra Budgetary Resources (EBRs) are funds raised by public agencies through issue of Govt. fully serviced bonds to augment infrastructure spending. Apart from EBR, financial supports have also been extended through loans from National Small Savings Fund (NSSF) to public agencies.
