(a) to (d): Repair, renovation and upgradation of facilities and infrastructure of Army hospitals to improve the healthcare services and functional efficiency of hospitals is undertaken regularly through Annual Works Programme, Special & Emergent Repairs and Revenue Works. Funds are allocated by the Services' Commands and Formation Headquarters for renovation and modernization in each Financial Year. No new hospitals have been sanctioned during last three years and current year.
