VACCINATION OF PEOPLE WITHOUT AADHAR CARD

250. SHRI BRIJLAL:

Will the Minister of **HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE** be pleased to state:

- (a) whether it is a fact that about 10 per cent of the people living in the country have not yet received even first dose of COVID-19 vaccines, if so, the details thereof, State-wise;
- (b) whether more number of people who have not got vaccinated is of those who do not have Aadhar card, if so, the plan for vaccination of such people; and
- (c) whether all the refugees living in the country have been vaccinated, if so, the details thereof?

(a) to (c) As on 26th November 2021, a total of 77.65 crore beneficiaries (82.7% coverage against estimated adult population aged 18 years and above) have received at least one dose of COVID-19 vaccine. The State/UT-wise details are at Annexure-1.

Data on segregation of unvaccinated persons on the basis of possession of prescribed identity card is not maintained, however, under National COVID-19 Vaccination Programme, there is provision to facilitate vaccination of persons without prescribed identity cards (including Aadhar Card) such as migrants, seers, nomads, refugees, destitutes, beggars etc. through special sessions where 100% vaccination is done through on-site registration by the vaccinator under a special procedure. As on 26th November 2021, a total of 34,54,379 doses of COVID-19 vaccines have been administered to such beneficiaries.

Government of India has also undertaken 'Har Ghar Dastak' campaign from 3rd November 2021 wherein missed beneficiaries for 1st dose and due beneficiaries for 2nd dose are identified and vaccinated through house to house activity.
