**DISPLACED PEOPLE DUE TO MINING PROJECTS IN CHHATTISGARH**

2508#: SHRI RAM VICHAR NETAM:

Will the Minister of MINES be pleased to state:

- (a) whether Government has reviewed the problems of the people displaced due to various mining projects in Chhattisgarh;
- (b) if so, the names of projects and districts in which they are located along with number of people displaced, district-wise details thereof; and
- (c) whether Government is taking any steps to solve their problems, if so, the details thereof?

**ANSWER**

- (a): State Government of Chhattisgarh has informed that under the State Rehabilitation and Resettlement Policy (R&R Policy), the problems related to displaced person/family/house are reviewed by the District Level Committee and resolved as per prescribed rules.
- (b): As per the information provided by the State Government of Chhattisgarh, a total of 125 people in the year 2019-20 and 201 people in the year 2020-21 have been displaced in the cases of land acquired for coal mines in coal-bearing districts. District wise information is attached at Annexure. No people have been displaced in respect of other minerals in last two years.
- (c): State Government of Chhattisgarh has informed that steps are taken as per prescribed norms in State Rehabilitation and Resettlement Policy (R&R Policy) for rehabilitation of displaced persons/families.
