ESTABLISHMENT OF HWCS UNDER AYUSHMAN BHARAT- PMJAY SCHEME

2639. SHRI ABDUL WAHAB:

Will the Minister of **HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE** be pleased to state:

- (a) the number of Health and Wellness Centres (HWCs) that have been built by Government against the announcement of 1,50,000 in February 2018 under Ayushman Bharat Scheme;
- (b) the expenditure and number of new HWCs built under this scheme since the inception, State-wise;
- (c) whether it is also a fact that very less people have taken benefits of PMJAY; and
- (d) if so, the details about PMJAY for the last three years, including number of families enrolled in PMJAY, number of families who benefitted, the total amount covered by the beneficiaries and the details of amount paid to insurance companies?

(a) and (b):

As per the budget announcement 2017-18, 1.5 lakh Sub-Health Centres (SHCs) and Primary Health Centres (PHCs) are to be transformed into Health and Wellness Centres (HWCs) by December, 2022. As on 14th December 2021, 80,764 AB-HWCs have been operationalized. This includes- Sub Health Centres (SHCs)-54,707, Primary Health Centres (PHCs)-21,894, Urban Primary Health Centres (UPHC-4,163) (*Source- AB-HWC Portal*). State-wise figures are at **Annexure-I**.

The expenditure under the scheme since inception is at **Annexure-II**.

(c) and (d)

"AB-PMJAY is an entitlement based scheme. No enrolment or registration is required under the scheme. Beneficiary can directly visit any empanelled public or private hospital to avail cashless health benefits. However, Ayushman cards are issued to the beneficiaries to create awareness about the scheme. As on 01st December, 2021, 17.21 crore Ayushman cards have been issued under the scheme.

As on 01st December, 2021, 2.50 crore hospital admissions worth Rs. 28,978.32 crore have been authorized under the scheme.

Medical claims raised by hospitals in respect of treatment taken by beneficiaries of the scheme are settled by insurance company/trust, as per the case. Central share of funds is released to States/UTs for the implementation of the scheme. During last three financial years viz. 2018-19, 2019-20 and 2020-21, an amount of Rs.7745.66 crore has been released to States/UTs."
