DEATHS DUE TO COVID-19 AFTER VACCINATION

266. DR. V. SIVADASAN:

Will the minister of **HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE** be pleased to state:

- (a) whether Government has the statistics regarding number of people who have been affected by COVID-19 after vaccination;
- (b) if so, the tabulated data based on which particular vaccine they have taken; and
- (c) the number of persons who have died of COVID-19 after getting vaccinated, vaccine-wise?

(a) to (c): As per the available scientific literature, most of the current COVID-19 vaccines are disease modifying in nature wherein mortality and hospitalizations are significantly reduced in vaccinated individuals. However, a proportion of the vaccinated individuals may still have mild or asymptomatic infections. Therefore, it is important to maintain COVID appropriate behaviour at all times including strict use of masks, follow social distancing and hand-washing.

Indian Council of Medical Research (ICMR) and Ministry of Health & Family Welfare (MoHF&W) have developed an India COVID-19 vaccination tracker which depicts the overall as well as age disaggregated information on numbers of COVID-19 deaths in unvaccinated individuals compared with numbers of deaths in partially and fully vaccinated individuals.
