**FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE TO STATE GOVERNMENTS BY PMKSY**

Will the Minister of JAL SHAKTI be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Central Government provides financial assistance to State Government for canal irrigation through various schemes under the Pradhan Mantri Krishi Sinchayee Yojana (PMKSY); and  
(b) if so, the details thereof for 2020-21 and 2021-22, year-wise, scheme-wise and State-wise with particular reference to the State of Uttar Pradesh?

(a) Yes, Sir. Central Government provides financial assistance to the identified projects of State Governments for canal irrigation under Accelerated Irrigation Benefit Programme (AIBP) and Har Khet Ko Pani–Surface Minor Irrigation (HKKP-SMI) components of Pradhan Mantri Krishi Sinchayee Yojana (PMKSY).

(b) The details of central assistance provided under PMKSY-AIBP and SMI components of PMKSY-HKKP for 2020-21 and 2021-22, year-wise, scheme-wise and State-wise, is given below:
