STATEMENT REFERRED TO IN REPLY OF RAJYA SABHA STARRED QUESTION NO. 173 FOR ANSWER ON 17.03.2022 BY SHRI SYED NASIR HUSSAIN REGARDING RECRUITMENT DRIVE IN ASPIRATIONAL DISTRICTS

(a): Filling up of vacancies, including backlog reserved vacancies, is a continuous process. Department of Personnel and Training (DoPT) issued instructions in 2014 to all Ministries/Departments to constitute an in-house Committee to take time bound measures to identify backlog reserved vacancies, study their root cause, to initiate measures to remove such factors and to fill up the backlog reserved vacancies, including through special recruitment drive. DoPT monitors the progress of filling up of backlog reserved vacancies for Scheduled Castes (SCs), Scheduled Tribes (STs) and Other Backward Classes (OBCs) with ten Ministries/Departments having more than 90% of the employees in Central Government and advises them to ensure that all backlog vacancies are filled in a time bound manner.

(b): Statement showing Ministry/Department-wise backlog reserved vacancies, as on 01.01.2021, is at **Annexure**.

(c): For filling up of vacancies in various Ministries/Departments of the Central Government, candidates from Aspirational Districts can participate in any recruitment process, including separate recruitment drive, if any.
