FUNDS ALLOCATION FOR TAP WATER RURAL AREAS UNDER JJM

1388 SHRI NEERAJ SHEKHAR:

Will the Minister of JAL SHAKTI be pleased to state:

- (a) the details of fund allocated, releases and utilized till 1st March, 2022 for provision of tap water in rural areas under Jal Jeevan Mission (JJM) to Uttar Pradesh during 2021-22;
- (b) the details of fund allocated under Budget 2022-23 for provision of tap water in rural areas under JJM, State-wise;
- (c) whether Government has allocated more funds under JJM to arsenic affected States during 2022-23 to provide arsenic free safe drinking water; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof, State-wise?

ANSWER

(a) Since August 2019, Government of India, in partnership with States, is implementing Jal Jeevan Mission (JJM), to make provision of potable tap water supply to every rural household of the country, including those of Uttar Pradesh, by 2024. The details of fund allocated, released and reported utilization under JJM in 2021-22 to Uttar Pradesh is as under:

(b) to (d) In 2022-23, an amount of Rs.60,000 Crore as Gross Budgetary Support (GBS) have been proposed for implementation of the mission. After approval of the budget, the State/ UT-wise allocation is decided as per approved allocation criteria in the beginning of the financial year. Further, while allocating the funds to States/ UTs, 10% weightage is been given to the population residing in habitations affected by chemical contaminants which *inter alia* includes Arsenic. Also, priority is given to quality-affected habitations while taking up schemes of potable tap water supply to rural households.
