Will the Minister of PETROLEUM AND NATURAL GAS be pleased to state:

- (a) the area and the heads where funds have been spent under the Corporate Social Responsibility (CSR) by various Public Sector Undertakings (PSUs) under the purview of Ministry of Petroleum and Natural Gas during the last three years and the amount of funds spent under each head during the same period;
- (b) the State-wise details thereof, especially that of the State of Bihar; and
- (c) the quantum of CSR funds available as of now, undertaking-wise?

(a)&(b) The Oil & Gas Public Sector Undertakings (PSUs), as a part of their Corporate Social Responsibility (CSR), undertake CSR activities under the heads identified under Schedule VII of the Companies Act 2013 with special focus on Health (Nutrition, Sanitation, and Drinking Water), Education, Skill Development, Rural Development, Women Empowerment, Environment oriented Initiatives and Care for the Elderly & Differently-abled persons, around their work centers with the approval of the Competent Authority.

Oil & Gas PSUs have spent Rs.5582.34 crore under CSR in various parts of the country including Bihar during the last three years (2018-19 to 2020-21).

Activity-wise details of CSR fund spent in the country and in the State of Bihar during the last 3 years by Oil & Gas PSUs are given in Annexure-1 & Annexure-2 respectively.

(c) Oil & Gas PSUs have informed that the available CSR fund for Financial Year 2021-22 have already been allocated.
