AYUSHMAN BHARAT YOJANA IN CHHATTISGARH

1527. SHRI RAM VICHAR NETAM:

Will the Minister of **HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE** be pleased to state:

- a) the details of the heads and the amount of funds allocated under them in Chhattisgarh by the Union Government under the Ayushman Bharat Yojana during the last three years;
- b) the number of patients benefitted under the Ayushman Bharat Yojana in Chhattisgarh and the amount of funds allocated by the Union Government for the same and the amount of funds targetted to be allocated from State's head; and
- c) the district-wise details of the number of families registered so far under the said scheme in the Ayushman Bharat Yojana in Chhattisgarh and the number of families remaining to be registered, district-wise?

- (a) to (c): Central share of funds is released to States/UTs as Grants-in-aid (General) for implementation of the scheme as well as for meeting administrative expenses. An amount of Rs. 392.99 crore is released to the State of Chhattisgarh during last three years.

As of 9th March, 2022, 21.96 lakh hospital admissions worth Rs. 2191 crore are authorized under the scheme. The State Government allocates its share as per funding pattern prescribed by Ministry of Finance.

1. Ayushman Bharat - PMJAY is implemented in Chhattisgarh in convergence with State based health insurance scheme Dr. Khubchand Baghel Swasthya Sahayata Yojana (DKBSSY). While eligible SECC families are supported by Centre and State Government, additional families are fully funded by the State Government.
2. Gaurela Pendra Marwahi district was formed from Bilaspur district in 2020. Since SECC survey was conducted in 2011, the corresponding SECC beneficiaries of GPM district are listed under Bilaspur district.
