Elephant corridor in Karnataka

- (a) the details of the proposed elephant corridors in the State of Karnataka;
- (b) the details of the land acquired and pending to be acquired from people and forest regions for elephant corridor, year and project-wise from 2017 in Karnataka; and
- (c) the details of compensation provided and pending to people from 2017, year and project wise?

- (a) As per the information received from the Government of Karnataka, following nine Elephant Corridors are identified in the State of Karnataka.

1.	Karadikkal- Madeshwara	Ragihalli corridor, Karnataka
2.	Tali - Bilikkal	Tamil Nadu and Karnataka
3.	Bilikkal – Javalagiri	Tamil Nadu and Karnataka
4.	Edayahalli – Guttiyalattur	Tamil Nadu and Karnataka
5.	Edayahalli – Doddasampige	Karnataka
6.	Chamarajanagar – Talamalai at Punjur	Tamil Nadu and Karnataka
7.	Chamarajanagar – Talamalai at Muddahalli	Tamil Nadu and Karnataka
8.	Kaniyanpura – Moyar	Karnataka
9.	Beguru - Brammagiri	Karnataka and Kerala

- (b)&(c) As per the information received from the Government of Karnataka, Edarahalli Doddasampige corridor has already been secured by purchasing 25.37 acres of private land in the year 2017. The details of compensation provided are not collated in the Ministry.
