LOSS OF JOBS FOR INDIANS DURING COVID-19 PANDEMIC

1817. SHRI JOSE K. MANI:

Will the Minister of **External Affairs** be pleased to state:

- (a) whether Government has the data regarding the number of Indians brought back from foreign countries under Vande Bharat Mission during the COVID-19 pandemic;
- (b) if so, the State-wise details thereof;
- (c) whether Government has any plans/proposals to support such persons who returned to India due to loss of their jobs abroad during the COVID-19 pandemic; and
- (d) if so, the details of the action taken in this regard?

ANSWER

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF EXTERNAL AFFAIRS [SHRI V. MURALEEDHARAN]

- (a) & (b) During the global Covid-19 pandemic, the Government of India launched the 'Vande Bharat' Mission to repatriate Indian nationals and to facilitate the travel of passengers between India and other parts of the world. As on 06 March 2022, 2.97 crore passengers (inbound and out-bound) have been facilitated in the flights operated under the Vande Bharat Mission and Air Bubble arrangements. The state-wise distribution of such passengers available as on 31 October 2021 is enclosed at **Annexure-I.**
- (c) & (d) Government of India launched the SWADES (Skilled Workers Arrival Database for Employment Support) initiative for citizens returning under the Vande Bharat Mission at the beginning of the pandemic. SWADES is a joint initiative of the Ministry of Skill Development and Entrepreneurship, the Ministry of Civil Aviation and the Ministry of External Affairs which aims to create a database of returning citizens based on their skill sets and experience.

As part of the SWADES initiative, the returning citizens were requested to fill an online SWADES Skills Card at http://www.nsdcindia.org/swades/. A call centre/SMS outreach was also conducted for citizens who arrived in India and did not complete SWADES registration. The information collected via the skills card was used to facilitate placement opportunities by integrating with Skill India's ASEEM (Aatmanirbhar Skilled Employee Employer Mapping) portal.
