(c): Of the above, corruption cases / departmental inquiries are pending in respect of 27 senior Civil Servants who are still in service, including 06 under suspension.

(d): Of the above, 24 senior Civil Servants were arrested during the course of investigation of the aforementioned cases and are presently on bail.
