SUPPLEMENTARY NUTRITION TO ADOLESCENT GIRLS IN UTTRAKHAND

2391. SHRI NARESH BANSAL:

Will the Minister of WOMEN AND CHILD DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) whether it is a fact that Government has taken steps to provide supplementary nutrition to adolescent girls especially in Uttarakhand and other Himalayan States under any centrally sponsored scheme;
- (b) if so, the State-wise details thereof;
- (c) the details of the steps taken by Government to identify adolescent girls to be covered under the scheme; and
- (d) the State-wise details of the beneficiaries?

ANSWER

(a) & (b) The Government of India is implementing the Scheme for Adolescent Girls (SAG), a Centrally Sponsored Scheme, which focused on out of school adolescent girls in the age group of 11-14 years across the country. Under the Scheme, nutritional support is provided to Adolescent Girls wherein supplementary nutrition containing 600 calories, 18-20 grams of protein and micro-nutrients is provided for 300 days in a year.

Recently the Scheme for Adolescent Girls has been subsumed under Saksham Anganwadi & Mission Poshan 2.0. As adolescent girls in the age group 11-14 years are covered under Right to Education Act, 2009, the targeted beneficiaries under the revised scheme are adolescent girls in the age group of 14+ to 18 years in Aspirational Districts and North Eastern States. State/UT-wise details of funds released under SAG including Uttarakhand and other Himalayan states, is at Annexure-I.

(c) Under SAG, the Anganwadi Worker undertakes home visits in her area, takes the help of PRIs, school teachers and other stakeholders to identify the beneficiaries.

(d) State/UT-wise details of beneficiaries under SAG is at Annexure-II.
