Performance of States in CAMPA fund utilization

Will the Minister of ENVIRONMENT, FOREST AND CLIMATE CHANGE be pleased to state:

- (a) details of total CAMPA fund utilization by States over the past five years;
- (b) performance review and analysis details of the States' performance in utilization of the CAMPA funds; and
- (c) socio-economic impact undertaken due to the CAMPA funds utilization?

- (a) The details of total CAMPA fund utilised by States/UTs during the past five years from 2016-17 to 2020-21 is enclosed in **Annexure-I**.
- (b) Monitoring and performance review of implementation of various activities are being done by States/UTs Forest Department through their Forest officers, Monitoring & Evaluation Wing and by involving independent third party agencies. Forest Survey of India also carries out analysis of geo-spatial data (polygons) of plantations uploaded by the State Forest Departments on e-Green Watch portal for accuracy of location, area and year of plantation. The analysis of plantations is available on e-Green Watch portal (www.egreenwatch.nic.in).
- (c) The CAMPA funds are being utilized by States/UTs for compensating the loss of forest & tree cover, ecological services and hydrological regime due to diversion of forest land for developmental projects through various afforestation activities, and forest & wildlife protection activities. The activities taken up under CAMPA fund have contributed to increase in forest & tree cover and various ecological services in the country, and enhancement of livelihood opportunities of the forest dependent communities.
