**INSTALLATION OF WEIGHING MACHINES AT ENTRY GATE OF
AIRPORTS**

Will the Minister of CIVIL AVIATION be pleased to state:-

- (a) whether Government has ensured the arrangement of facility for free of cost weighing of the check-in luggage of the passengers before the check-in process, near all the entry gates of all the airports of the country so that passengers may not face any trouble after check-in and rearrange the luggage in case the weight of luggage exceeds the fixed limit well before the check-in process;**
- (b) if so, the number of airports where the said facility has been made operational so far; and**
- (c) if not, by when Government would ensure such a smooth arrangement?**

(a) to (c): Consistent efforts are made by Airports Authority of India (AAI) and other airport operators to provide best facilities at airports in keeping with the passengers needs. In line with providing such amenities, the facility of free of cost weighing of the check-in luggage of the passengers is available before the check-in process, near the entry gates at 38 airports managed by the AAI and nine other Joint Venture (JV)/Public Private Partnership (PPP) airports.
