Construction of campuses of central educational institutions in Andhra Pradesh

Will the Minister of **EDUCATION** be pleased to state:

- (a) list of various Central educational institutions established in present day (residual) Andhra Pradesh before May, 2014 and after May 2014;
- (b) the status of construction of permanent campuses of IIM Visakhapatnam, IIT Tirupati, IISER Tirupati, NIT Tadepalligudem and IIITD&M Kurnool;
- (c) the likely date of completion of permanent campus of above-mentioned institutions;
- (d) funds sanctioned for above-mentioned institutions for different phases, funds released and spent so far;
- (e) reasons for delay in construction of Central University in Anantapur and likely date of commencement; and
- (f) details of land allocated for Tribal University in Vizianagaram?

(a) List of Central educational institutions established in present day (residual) Andhra Pradesh before May, 2014 and after May 2014 is given at **Annexure-I**.

(b) to (d) The status of construction of permanent campuses, likely date of completion of permanent campuses, funds sanctioned, released and spent for IIM Visakhapatnam, IIT Tirupati, IISER Tirupati, NIT Tadepalligudem and IIITD&M Kurnool is given at **Annexure –II**.

(e) The Central University of Andhra Pradesh (CUAP) has started functioning from the temporary campus (transit camps) at Anantapur District from the academic year 2018-19. CUAP has taken over 491.30 Acre of land at Ananthapur District, on 15.02.2021 from the Government of Andhra Pradesh for construction of permanent campus. Master plan for establishment of CUAP has been prepared as per approved Detailed Project Report.

(f) Site Selection Committee (SSC) recommended the site at Vijianagram District, Andhra Pradesh for establishment of the permanent campus of Central Tribal University of Andhra Pradesh (CTUAP). The same has been conveyed to State Government of Andhra Pradesh in the month of November, 2021 with a request to transfer the land to CTUAP.
