- (a) the share of Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises (MSMEs) in the basket of export to Russia and Ukraine;
- (b) whether small enterprises have been hit most by the shortage of raw material as a result of Russia-Ukraine war crisis; and
- (c) the steps taken/proposed to be taken to compensate the losses borne by the small entrepreneurs because of Russia-Ukraine war?
