FUNCTIONAL MEGA TEXTILE PARKS IN THE COUNTRY

3511. SHRI NEERAJ SHEKHAR:

Will the Minister of TEXTILES be pleased to state:

- (a) the details of mega textiles parks functional in the country as on date, State-wise;
- (b) the details of proposals for setting up of mega textile parks received during 2021-22 till 31 March, 2022, State-wise along with present status thereof;
- (c) the details of mega textiles parks accorded approval till 31 March, 2022, during 2021-22, location-wise and State-wise along with fund allocated, released and utilized for the same; and
- (d) the details of mega textiles parks for approval as on 31 March, 2022, location-wise and State-wise?

ANSWER

(a): Under Comprehensive Powerloom/ Silk Cluster Development Scheme, Powerloom Mega Clusters were approved for Erode, Ichalkaranji, Surat and Mysore. The projects at Erode have been completed while the project at Ichalkaranji is on the verge of completion. Mysore Silk Mega Cluster and Surat Powerloom Mega Cluster are at various stages of implementation. Apart from this, 56 Textile parks have been sanctioned under Scheme for Integrated Textile Parks, out of which 27 textile parks have been completed while 29 textiles parks are at various stages of implementation.

(b): The Government has approved setting up of 7 (Seven) PM Mega Integrated Textile Region and Apparel (PM MITRA) Parks in Greenfield/Brownfield sites to develop world class infrastructure including plug and play facility with an outlay of Rs.4,445 Crore for a period of seven years upto 2027-28. All State Governments were requested to send proposal along with Preliminary Project Report to the Ministry by 15.03.2022 for consideration. A total of 17 Preliminary Project Reports (PPRs) from 13 State Governments have been received, details of which are as under: -
